**Saturday, August 25<sup>th</sup> 2012:** Depart for Leipzig, Germany

Board our private **G550 Gulfstream Jet** in North America. Before leaving we'll enjoy a farewell **breakfast party** at our private departure terminal(s). After lunch you will have time to explore this charming place and enjoy some shopping.



We will then drive south on the “No speed limit Autobahn” towards Lindau, located at Lake Constance. In the late afternoon we arrive at your **5-Star Hotel Bayerischer Hof**, where you’ll check in your spacious deluxe accommodations overlooking **Lake Constance**. Tonight we have planned a welcome to the **Alps Dinner**.

**Wednesday, August 29<sup>th</sup> 2012** – Zeppelin Flight over Bodensee ( ~ 60 kms = 40 mi )

First enjoy your **breakfast** at the **Bayerischer Hof**. Today we take only a short drive and you will enjoy another highlight of your trip. We will drive along Lake Constance to Friedrichshafen, the city where once the Zeppelin “**Graf Hindenburg**” was built. We first will visit the Zeppelin Museum and the hangar where the Zeppelins are built today before we are boarding the Zeppelin for a 60 minutes flight



over Lake Constance. Then, you’ll have plenty of time to **relax** and get some **shopping** done in the afternoon. Lindau is a delightful little town.



After this exciting flight, we are driving back to our Hotel **Bayerischer**



**Hof** in Lindau, where we take a little rest, or have time for some shopping, freshen up, and leave for our **Bodensee-Dinner** which will be served on one of the oldest ships operating on Lake Constance. While we are having our Cocktail reception and our Dinner, the **MS Emily** yacht will take us around on Lake Constance. We will have a light **Lunch** before returning to our cars, driving west to the city of Romanshorn, where we take the **Lake Constance ferry** back to the German side of Lake Constance. We will be back in time at the **Bayerischer Hof** in Lindau, so you can enjoy the old part of the island Lindau. Tonight we have planned another spectacular **Dinner** and cocktails at the **Bayerischer Hof**. You'll get a good night's rest with one of the most amazing views from your private balcony overlooking Lake Constance.

**Friday, August 31<sup>st</sup> 2012** – Drive to Weggis, Lake Lucerne, Switzerland ( ~150 kms = 95 mi )

Once we arrived on top of the pass, which is 6,404 feet, we take a little break before we descend towards Lake Lucerne.

After this day full of wonderful impressions you deserved another **5-Star Hotel** to relax and enjoy. In the late afternoon we arrive at the **Park Hotel Weggis**. Check in your suite overlooking the lake and mountains and freshen up. The chef will prepare a welcome to “Lake Lucerne” **Dinner** for us tonight. Enjoy his delightful creations accompanied by corresponding wines. Have a good night's rest at the **Park Hotel Weggis**.

**Saturday, September 1<sup>st</sup> 2012** – Swiss Mountain Pass Driving ( ~ 200 kms = 125 mi )

At the Park Hotel Weggis **Breakfast** will be served on the terrace overlooking Lake Lucerne. We have planned to drive over **THREE Alpine Passes**, each between 7,000 and 8,000 feet high. The **Furka, Grimsel** and **Susten Passes** are THE most famous Swiss mountain passes which are every PORSCHE driver's goal. Weather and time permitting we will stop at **Belvedere** and have a walk into the **Rhone**



**Glacier**. Once we passed the top of the Grimsel Pass, we stop for **Lunch** at the **Grimsel Hospiz**. After Lunch there will be the third Pass to cross, the **Susten Pass**. In the afternoon we drive back to our **5-Star Hotel Park Hotel Weggis**.



We all deserved a drink while we go over the amazing driving experience of today. A motor coach will bring us then to the village of Vitznau, where we board an antic train up to the **Rigi Mountain**. Enjoy cocktails and a fabulous **Dinner** at the Michelin rated **Hotel**

**Bergsonne** overlooking Lake Lucerne. The train will bring us back to Vitznau, where our luxurious coach is waiting for bringing us back to the **Park Hotel Weggis**.

You'll enjoy a good night's rest in the crisp fresh Swiss mountain air.



**Sunday, September 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012** – Drive to Tegernsee, Germany via Austria ( ~ 380 kms = 240 mi )

Your large luggage will be loaded on our **luggage truck** and in your room at the **Seehotel Überfahrt** when we arrive in the late afternoon. We will drive north-east wards on the Swiss – and Austrian Autobahn, before we are turning onto one of the most beautiful and scenic roads in Europe, the **Silvretta Hochalpenstrasse**.

We will have a light **Lunch** en route in one of the small villages

along the way. We will pass the city of Innsbruck on the Austrian Autobahn, before we go back on scenic back roads, passing the Achensee and crossing another small Pass the **Achenpass**.

In the late afternoon we arrive at our new destination, the **5-Star Hotel Seehotel Überfahrt** located at one of the most beautiful lakes



in Germany, the **Tegernsee**. The hotel also features a magnificent spa and wellness facility.



Your luggage is already in your room. Freshen up and relax on your private balcony overlooking Lake Tegernsee.

We close our amazing day with a **Champagne Reception** followed by a delicious **Dinner**. The local Bavarian cuisine is known for fresh organic vegetables and great wines. Have a good nights rest in the **Seehotel Überfahrt**.

Upon our return to the dock in Rottach-Egern, we will have organized transfers back to the **Seehotel Überfahrt**. We will take the time to make a short stop at the Gerlos Waterfalls, before we continue driving east towards **Zell am See**, where we are having our **Lunch** at the PORSCHE property: **Schloss Prielau**. We plan to visit **Dr. Porsche's** family chapel at the Porsche Family property near Zell am See to pay our respect and show our admiration.





We then continue our drive directly to the traditional **Hotel Sacher**, THE traditional Hotel in **Salzburg**. Your big luggage will already be in your room when we arrive.

Today we will drive over the highest Alpine Pass the **Grossglockner Mountain Pass**. On the southern side of the Grossglockner Pass we will drive straight into the **Malta Tal** (Malta Valley), where we have **Lunch** in an old Farmhouse, which is now the fabulous



Restaurant named **Falleralm**. We then visit the **HQ of the original PORSCHE Factory in Gmünd** which has been lovingly preserved by Helmut Pfeifhofer who is also the owner and curator of the Gmünder PORSCHE Museum which we, of course, will also visit.

Helmut personally will share his collection with us and tell stories of the “old days.” With his passion for PORSCHE Helmut Pfeifhofer built up an amazing collection of cars since the 1940’s to show PORSCHE enthusiasts from all over the world. A short two-hour drive will bring us back to Salzburg via the **Austrian Autobahn**.



Tonight we'll enjoy a raucous evening at an **Austrian Almhütte** with the charming Zither music of Sepp Nußbaumer, **Dinner** of local cuisine and beer and wine from the Salzburg region. You'll love this 12<sup>th</sup> century farm and the dinner cooked on an open fire. Just watch out for the local white Brandy, or Enzian as it's called. A 20-minute coach ride will get us back to a good night's rest at the **Hotel Sacher Salzburg**.

**Thursday, September 6<sup>th</sup> 2012 – Photo Rally ( ~ 200 kms = 125 mi )**

We will enjoy our delicious **Breakfast** at the **Hotel Sacher**. Today we'll have a fun day. It's “Photo Rally time”, which means, that we will show you another scenic part of Austria, while driving on scenic back roads. Your circumspect abilities will be challenged. The rally is through the scenic **Salzkammergut Lake District**.



There is no need for you to take pictures, although you really will want to. You'll get a rally booklet with a series of pictures in it. Each picture has one or more questions. When you drive the prescribed route, you'll run across these clues and write your response on

the last page. The responses will be graded and the appropriate responses will be scored.

We will take **Lunch** at the regal **Castle Fuschl** overlooking Lake Fuschl. In the afternoon we have planned a **Sound of Music Sightseeing** tour in **horse-drawn carriages**, Fiaker, as the



locals call them, throughout Salzburg. You can do some shopping in the Getreidegasse. Tonight will be our famous **rally dinner** where very “valuable” prizes will be awarded at the Hotel Sacher.

**Friday, September 07<sup>th</sup> 2012** – Colmberg to Castle Friedrichsruhe ( ~ 500 kms = 310 mi )

Enjoy this amazing view from the castle into Frankonia and the delicious local cuisine. **5-Star Hotel Schlosshotel Friedrichsruhe**, located in the middle of nature, close to the “Löwensteiner Berge” (Loewensteiner Mountains). Check in your luxury suites freshen up and relax, before we meet for our

**Cocktail reception** followed by a star rated **Dinner**. Have a good night's rest at the **Schlosshotel Friedrichsruhe**.



**Saturday, September 8<sup>th</sup> 2012:** Friedrichsruhe to Stuttgart ( ~ 120 kms = 75 mi )

You will start your day with a superb **Breakfast**, before you drive to Stuttgart to the all re-designed and re-built Hotel **Graf Zeppelin**. Check in your suites, return your cars and freshen up. Your luxury coach will be waiting in front of the Hotel to bring you to the PORSCHE Museum, where you will have **Lunch** in the PORSCHE Restaurant **Christophorus**, which is rated as one of the best Restaurants in Stuttgart. After lunch, you will get a exclusive guided tour through the new PORSCHE Museum. 3. You may choose not to come on the private jet or commercial first class and make your own flight arrangements, in which case the appropriate price adjustment is shown below.
4. We will **provide you with a PORSCHE** 911-991, Cayman S, Panamera S or Cayenne. All gasoline, tolls, parking, car washes and excess kilometers, per itinerary, are included.
5. Or you may choose to **have us ship your own car to Europe** at our expense. We will handle all the details and have included the shipping cost from the East Coast to Bremerhaven and back to the East Coast. The transport of your car from your home to the East Coast departure port is not included and will be billed separately. We need to have your vehicle ready for shipping at least four weeks prior to departure. Likewise, for the duration of the trip, in your own car, all gasoline, tolls, parking and car washes are included. However, you will have to obtain additional insurance and the ADAC membership, which we will help organize for you.
6. For every four or five vehicles we have a **professional drive guide** leading the group. We are all connected with two-way radios. You may also drive individually on your own with your GPS.
7. You'll benefit from our **local venue and people knowledge** as well as our **fluency in German**.
8. **All accommodations are 5-Star** properties and are junior suites or better, subject to availability.
